3. <u>Dug Out Assignments</u>

a. The team listed at the top of the bracket will be in the 1st Base dugout and will be the visiting team. The team listed at the bottom of the bracket will be in the 3rd Base dugout and will be the home team.

4. <u>Batting Practice & Infield/Outfield Practice</u>

a. No cages available. No live hitting on field. No hitting into fences. Hitting whiffle balls is allowed, however, batters must be on warning track / dirt to protect the turf.

- c. 3:30 game: Home team (3:00 pm to 3:10 pm); Visiting team (3:10 pm to 3:20 pm)
- d. 6:30 game: Home team (6:00 pm to 6:10 pm); Visiting team (6:10 pm to 6:20 pm)

7. <u>Introductions</u> (10 minutes prior to game time)

a. Players, coaches and team managers will line up on baselines. Visitors introduced first. Please have team ready. Pledge of Allegiance will immediately follow introductions for the 1st game of the day.

8. Rain Out Schedule

- a. If weather forces us to reschedule, I will work with the teams involved to reschedule the games.
- b. Warning! Sunday will be an option if we have rain on Saturday.

9. Suspended Game

a. Once a game has begun, and before five complete innings are completed, if the weather or darkness causes the umpires to stop play, the game will be resumed at the point of suspension.

15. Protests (NFHS Rule 10.2.i.1)

- If there is a question about a rule that was possibly misapplied, the team's coach or captain shall inform the umpire at time of the play and before a pitch to the next batter of either team, or before the umpires leave the field if the play in question was the last play of the game.
- Protest committee will consult with umpires and coaches and make decision as to the best way to proceed with the contest.
- Tournament director will determine members of the protest committee.
- 16. The use of unmanned aerial vehicles ("UAV"), also known as drones, is prohibited for any purpose by any persons at WCD tournament venues. Tournament management shall refuse admission or entry for anyone attempting to use a UAV; and if necessary, tournament management shall remove anyone attempting to use a UAV and/or confiscate the UAV until the event has been completed. For purposes of this policy, a UAV is any aircraft without a human pilot aboard the device.
